Try this sweet but simple recipe!

Easy Almond Roca

Ingredients: 1 C butter, 1 C brown sugar; 40 whole saltine crackers; 12 oz. semi-sweet chocolate chips; 1/2-1 C chopped almonds.

Directions: Lay a jelly roll pan (11 X 17 X 1) with foil and line pan with crackers. Heat oven to 350 degrees. Melt butter & sugar in saucepan and bring to boil for 2 min. Remove from heat and pour over crackers to cover. Bake in oven for 5 min until bubbling over but watch carefully. Remove from oven and top with chocolate chips right away and let melt. Spread smoothly over crackers & cover with nuts immediately. Refrigerate to harden only, then break up in pieces and
